Priority 1:

To further develop the wider curriculum to ensure that it is ambitious, progressive, cohesive from EYFS to Y6.

Priority 3:

To select and implement a validated Phonics scheme which will provide consistency in Phonics teaching, targeted intervention for less able pupils and to support children's fluency in reading.

Priority 5:

To improve attendance and punctuality across the school; in particular for vulnerable groups.
