In this unit, pupils explore and experiment with how they can use their mark making skills to both be influenced by, and to capture, the expression in music. Children then explore making inventive instruments by creating a class "orchestra".

## Exploring the World Through Mono Print

Change, Grow, Live



Here, pupils explore observational drawing and experimental mark making, and think about how they can use composition to create their artwork. They begin to develop hand-eye coordination through slow and paced observations.

## Explore and Draw

Wax Resist Autumn Leaves



This pathway begins with two explorations of drawing - one drawing from photographs or film, and two drawing from small, closely observed objects. Children are introduced to simple mono print techniques whilst being encouraged to take creative risks.

## Playful Making

Making Rollercoasters



Children are introduced to what sculpture can be and are invited to explore the work of other sculptors whilst taking a playful and inventive approach to making their own sculptures - rollercoasters.

In this unit, pupils will have the opportunity to explore the world around them through print. They will discover how they can build up images by creating multiples and use line, shape, colour and texture to explore pattern, sequencing and symmetry.
