Subject: Religious Education

Spiritual

 RE enables pupils to explore big questions about life, belonging and purpose. Children reflect on their own ideas and develop a sense of awe, wonder and curiosity about the world and the beliefs of others.

Moral

 Pupils learn about values such as kindness, fairness and respect through stories and teachings from different religions. They develop an understanding of right and wrong and consider how their actions affect others.

Social

 Through RE, children develop skills for working together, listening carefully and respecting different viewpoints. They learn about how people live in communities and how beliefs influence how people behave.

Cultural

 Pupils explore a variety of religions and worldviews, including festivals, traditions and ways of life. This builds cultural awareness and helps them appreciate the diversity within their school, community and wider society.
